Residents to Learn, Share Ideas about Water Quality in Upper San Antonio River

WHAT: First public meeting of the new Watershed Protection Plan (WPP), designed to assess and improve water quality in the Upper San Antonio River, reaching from North Loop 1604 to Loop 410 South.

NOTES: Results of water quality studies will be shared with attendees, sources of bacterial pollution will be discussed and potential water quality improvement projects will be explored. The WPP began this year with \$400,000 in funding from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the San Antonio River Authority.
